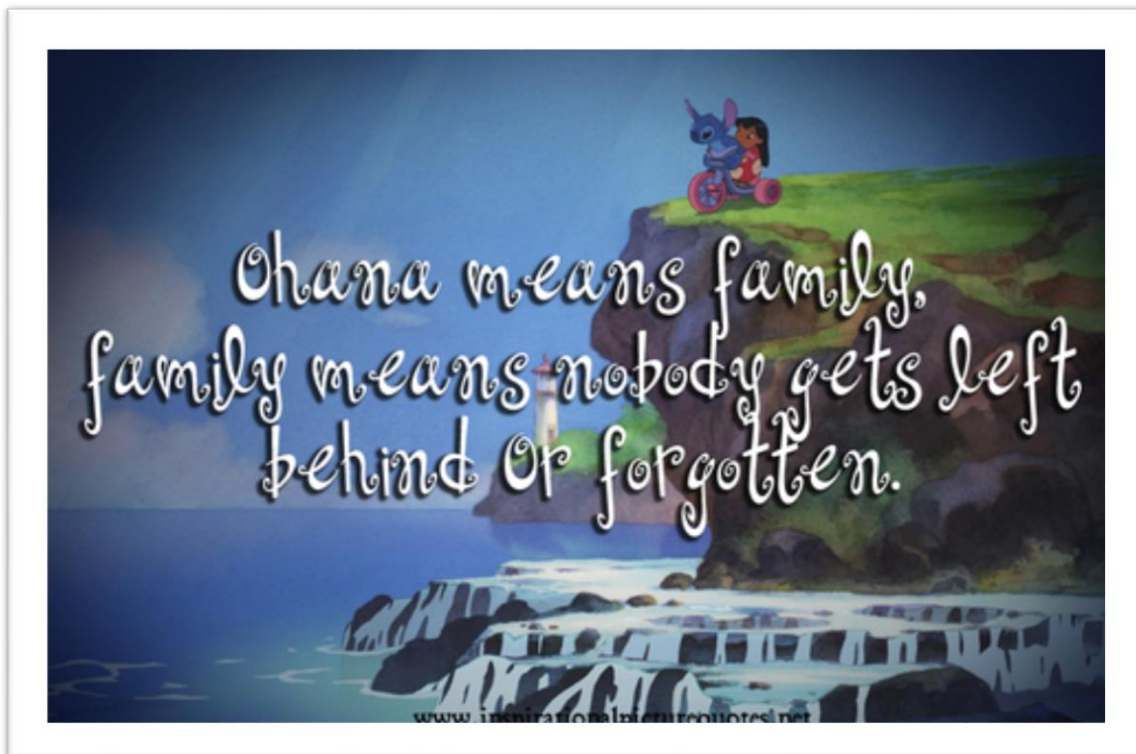
OUR LEARNING FOR LIFE AWARD WINNER FOR AUGUST!
