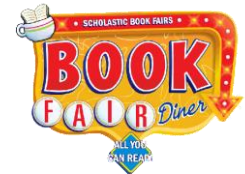
Students must attend at least 4 hours of the school day on the day of the dance.

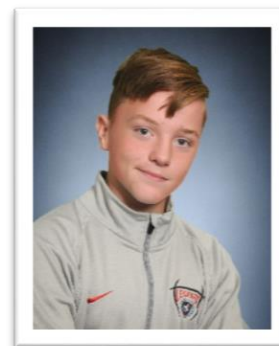

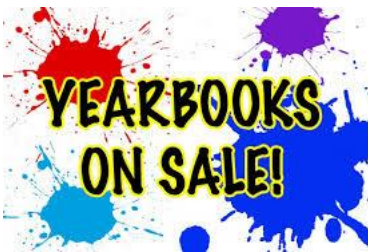
