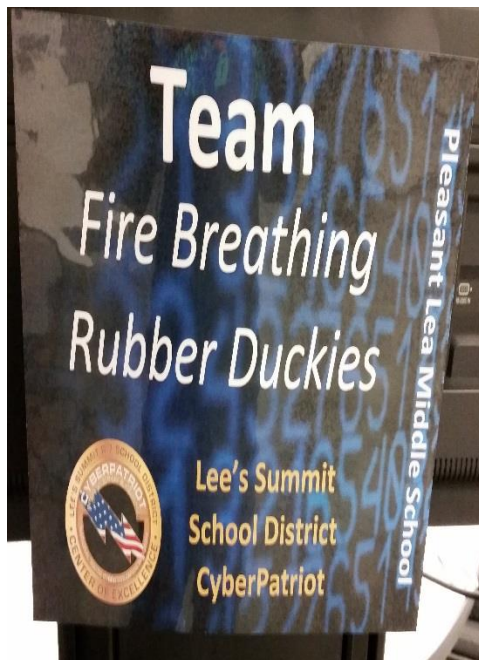

### CONGRATULATIONS PLMS CYBER PATRIOT TEAMS

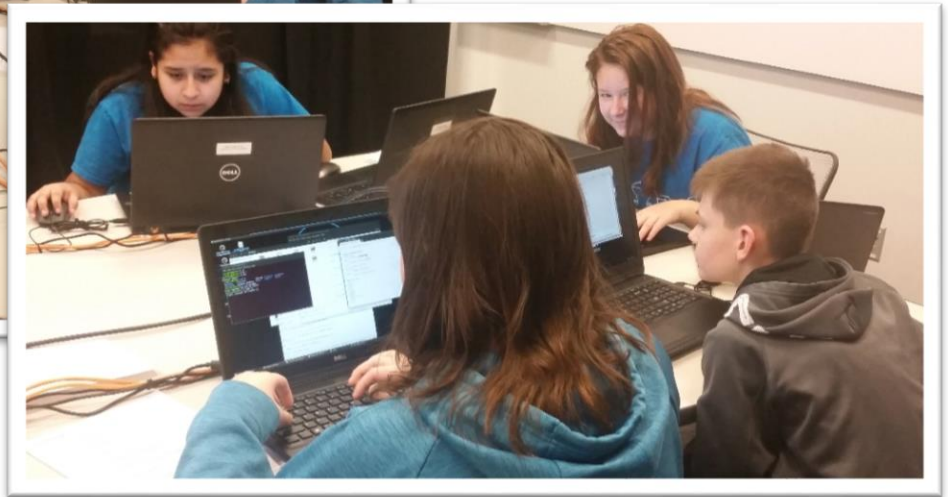
Our apologies as we neglected to include the pictures of our Fire Breathing Rubber Duckies.
