USE "MY SCHOOL BUCKS" TO TRACK STUDENTS MEALS

Lee's Summit R-7 School District families have the opportunity to track their children's school lunch and breakfast purchases, check meal account balances, receive low-balance alerts and pay for meals through a web-based program known as My School Bucks. The convenient meal online payment and monitoring program is available on the R-7 Nutrition Services webpage (upper right portion of page) at <http://leessummitschoolnutrition.com>.



A link is also on the PLMS website plms.lsr7.org in the NUTRITION page at the top black banner.

By using My School Bucks, families have a safe and secure option for managing their children's school breakfast and lunch payments via their digital devices. Parents receive their own secure login and create a password using their student's ID number. The option to track accounts, monitor student cafeteria purchases, check balances and receive low-balance e-mail alerts is free. A \$2.49 transaction fee is charged for online payments.
