## LIBRARY MEDIA CENTER

The Media Center is open each school day from 7:15 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. A student may enter the library at any time during the school day with a pass from a teacher. The Media Center contains a wide variety of excellent reference and recreational reading materials. Students must use ID labels/cards to check out materials.

A student may check out 3 materials from the library. This includes books, audio books, and magazines. Items may be checked out for 4 weeks at a time. Additionally, the media center has e-book check out. The policies and procedures for e-book check out can be given to you by the librarian. The Media Center sponsors a variety of activities throughout the school year ranging from book clubs, family literacy events, and reading incentives. ## DETENTIONS

Students are assigned Wednesday detentions through the office by the administration for failing to follow school rules and regulations.
